The project builds upon the initiative "YOUTH4SDGs: Youth for Sustainable Development in Podravina" with the aim of strengthening the SUMA Association and youth in the field of sustainable development through active participation in social and political activities. Through a study visit to Slovenia, panel discussions, and promotion, the project will connect youth and decision-makers from Podravina with innovative practices such as participatory budgeting and youth centers. This will popularize models of civic participation and enable the transfer of knowledge from Slovenia to local communities in Croatia, enhancing motivation and capacities for citizen engagement.

## **Expected Results**

- > Strengthened capacities of the SUMA Association for popularizing active citizenship:
  - Participation of **3 members of the SUMA Association** in the study visit.
  - At least 5 collaborations established with local and regional self-governments (LRSGs) and CSOs.
  - **1 panel discussion** organized with participants upon return from the study visit.

## > Improved understanding of civic participation processes among decision-makers and youth:

- 9 decision-makers (from LRSGs and CSOs) included in the study visit.
- **5 youth representatives** (youth councils, student council representatives, and youth organizations) involved.
- **20 participants** attended the panel discussion.
- **75% of participants** demonstrated better understanding of participation processes before and after the study visit.
- Media coverage of the project included 4 publications in public media outlets.
