Gender-based violence/violence against women is a societal issue that, unfortunately, we witness far too often. It does not only impact women but also affects families, communities, and society as a whole, creating an environment of fear, insecurity, and inequality.

We learn about equality, gender equality, and violence prevention from an early age. The ROZA for Women project will encourage initiatives in primary and secondary schools in Eastern Croatia, focused on learning and organizing activities within schools and communities that promote women's rights, gender equality, and raise awareness about rejecting gender-based violence. In 10 communities, schools will organize activities related to the 16 Days of Activism against Gender-Based Violence and International Women's Day – March 8th.

Expected Project Results

A three-day training will be conducted for 20 teachers, educators, and professors from 10 primary and/or secondary schools and one university program. The training will focus on women's rights, gender equality, and addressing the lack of awareness about gender-based violence.

After the training, teachers and professors will conduct workshops in their schools/university, engaging 150 students. These students will design and implement activities in their communities during the 16 Days of Activism against Gender-Based Violence.

Students will create recommendations aimed at strengthening their schools' efforts in promoting gender equality, women's human rights, and reducing discrimination. These recommendations will be presented to decision-makers (school principals) for adoption.

A ROZA for Women media campaign will be carried out before and during the 16 Days of Activism. Additionally, International Women's Day will be marked twice by organizing a March 8th rally.
