6. Lesbian Organisation Rijeka - LORI: Safety and Equality in Classrooms

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Project duration	18 months (1.11.2023 – 30.4.2025)

Schools are often not safe spaces for young people who are "different." Due to their sexual orientation or gender identity and expression, **LGBTIQ+ youth** (lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, intersex, and queer individuals) are at a greater risk of experiencing peer violence, negative experiences during schooling, and minority stress. A non-supportive school climate negatively impacts students' health and academic performance and often leaves long-term consequences on the mental and physical well-being of young people.

The overall goal of the project "Safety and Equality in School Desks" is to improve practices of inclusivity, equality, and non-discrimination in education and to ensure support for LGBTIQ+ youth.

The project aims to raise awareness about the negative experiences that LGBTIQ+ youth face in schools and highlight the importance of creating an accepting and inclusive environment. Project activities include the development of a **Handbook for teaching staff** on how to prevent violence experienced by young people due to their sexual orientation and/or gender identity and expression, as well as on providing support to LGBTIQ+ students. Additionally, to reduce derogatory language and increase the acceptance of LGBTIQ+ students in schools, a **campaign**, **panel discussion**, and **educational activities** for students and teaching staff will be implemented.

Expected Project Results:

Increased capacity of educational institutions to combat LGBTI-phobic language and peer violence

- 20 teachers will be trained on methods to prevent violence in schools and provide support to LGBTIQ+ students.
- We expect that at least half of the trained teachers will conduct similar educational activities in their schools, reaching at least 120 students.
- A Handbook for teaching staff on preventing violence experienced by LGBTIQ+ youth will be developed and distributed to 750 educational institutions.

Increased awareness among youth and the wider public in Primorje-Gorski Kotar County about the harm caused by LGBTI-phobic language and violence and the importance of reporting it.

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- This will be achieved through an online public campaign, a panel discussion on LGBTIQ-phobia in the education system, and educational activities conducted by trained teachers.
- We expect that at least 75% of the participating youth will have a better understanding of the issue of LGBTI-phobic language and violence and be more willing to report it.

Empowered and supported 20 LGBTIQ+ youth in exercising their rights.

 This will be achieved by providing free psychological and legal support to 20 LGBTIQ+ youth.
