Main project goals:

The goal of this project is to ensure the accountability of institutions and provide support to victims of discrimination, especially in the field of health care, through legal analysis of the possibility of filing lawsuits, informing victims about their rights and court procedures, and providing advisory support. At the same time, the project seeks to raise public awareness of the necessity of institutional responsibility and the availability of legal protection for victims, with special emphasis on the case of the Clinical Hospital Center in Osijek, which did not take disciplinary measures against a doctor wrongfully convicted of crimes of rape and fornication.

Expected project results:

The expected results of the project include **strengthening institutional responsibility and providing support to victims of discrimination** through legal analysis, information, counseling and public campaigning. As a result of the legal analysis, a detailed review of the legal options for filing a lawsuit due to discrimination will be made, along with an analysis of one specific case.

Informing the victims will result in the printing of brochures with legal instructions, distribution through organizations, law offices and public institutions, and the publication of a legal roadmap on the organization's website.

Counseling support will enable continuous legal assistance to victims through individual counseling and distribution of informational materials.

Through the **"Say NO to discrimination"** campaign, the public will be educated about the responsibility of institutions and the legal options of victims through social networks, media announcements and the final press conference, which will significantly increase awareness of the problem of discrimination and available legal protection mechanisms.
